2. US-Ireland Research and Development Partnership Programme (HRB)

The Partnership Programme aims to generate discoveries and innovations which will lead to **enhancements in health, disease prevention and healthcare.**

Applicants: The application must have a minimum of one applicant from each of the three jurisdictions (Rep IRE, NI, US); however, significant participation by researchers in all jurisdictions must be demonstrated in the application.

Process:

- Intention to submit: **Rolling call with 10 weeks in advance of the full proposal deadline at NIH.**
- Almost final full application: **Six weeks in advance of the relevant NIH deadline.**

3. Cancer Research Network Award (Irish Cancer Society)

Purpose: To contribute towards the cost of **developing and hosting networking initiatives, training activities, collaborations, partnerships, or another type of networking activity** (e.g., host a workshop/conference). The Society is open to all networking initiatives that satisfy the purpose and objectives of the call.

Submission Deadline: 5th June @3pm

Funding: max €2,000 (only one application/ applicant)

Application process: Irish Cancer Society [Gateway Grant Tracker](#) online system
